Sample Bulletin Announcements

Mother's Day Announcement:

The Bottles for Babies Campaign starts today! The campaign makes it easy for you to participate in the ministry of the Women's Care Center of Sevier County, Inc. Just pick up a bottle as you leave today and fill it with coins and cash or checks payable to the Women's Care Center. Bring it back to church in five weeks on Father's Day.

May 18 Announcement:

Remember that baby bottle you picked up last week? Keep filling it with coins, cash or checks payable to the Women's Care Center of Sevier County, Inc.

May 25 Announcement:

The Bottles for Babies Campaign enables everyone to participate in a small but meaningful way. Each family member from the youngest pre-schooler to the oldest grandparent can add his or her contribution to the bottle that saves babies.

June 1 Announcement:

Even little gifts can make a big difference in helping the Women's Care Center carry out its ministry, and the Bottles for Babies Campaign makes it easy for us to combine our change to make a significant contribution. Keep filling your bottle!

June 8 Announcement:

You have been filling your baby bottle with spare change, cash or a check payable to the Women's Care Center since Mother's Day. Don't forget to bring your bottle back to church with you next week so we can return all bottles to the WCC!

Father's Day Announcement:

Did you bring your baby bottle back today? The Bottles for Babies Campaign for the Women's Care Center of Sevier County, Inc. ends today, and we are collecting the bottles to return them to the WCC. If you forgot to bring your bottle today, you can bring it to church next Sunday or drop it off at 304 Eastgate Road, Sevierville.

June 22 Announcement:

Do you still have your baby bottle? The Women's Care Center is now counting all the change we raised to help women and men in our community facing unplanned pregnancies. Bring your bottle back to church or drop it off at the WCC so your change can be a part of that too! If you haven't had a chance to fill your bottle, please return it anyway so it can be used again next year.
